Last Will and Testament

THIS WILL is made by me MR JIMMY JAMES SCOTT of 77 Alma Road, Clifton, Bristol, City of Bristol, England, BS8 2DP.

1. Revocation

I revoke all earlier Wills.

2. Appointment of Executors

2.1. I appoint Stephanie Evans of 16 Bristol, City of Bristol, England, BS2 to be my executor and trustee.

2.2. If Stephanie Evans is unable or unwilling to act as one of my Executors and Trustees or dies before proving my Will I make the following appointment to replace the said Stephanie Evans.

2.3. I appoint Jeremy Twedell of 73 Dyrham Road, Bristol, South Gloucestershire, England, BS15 4HW as my substitute executor and trustee.

2.4. The expression "**my Trustees**" means my personal representatives and the trustees of this Will and of any trust that might arise under it.

3. Provision for Pets

I wish and desire that all pets I own at the date of my death shall be provided with a good home for the remainder of their natural lives and to this end, I give my pets together with the sum of £5000.00 free of all taxes to James Smith of 14 Poplar Road, Speedwell, Bristol, City of Bristol, England, BS5 7TP on the understanding that James Smith will honour my wishes concerning the welfare of my pets.

4. Money Bequests

4.1. I give the following gifts free of inheritance tax;

4.2. I give the sum of £6000.00 to James Smith.

4.3. I give the sum of £10000.00 to *charity name*.

5. Specific Gifts

I give the following gifts free of inheritance tax;

5.1. I give to James Smith: My Motor Bike .

6. Definition of my Estate

In my Will where the context so admits "**my Estate**" shall mean:

- 6.1. All my property of every kind wherever situated.
- 6.2. All my property of every kind wherever situated over which I have general power of appointment.
- 6.3. The money investments and property from time to time representing all such property.

7. **Administration of my Estate**

My Trustees shall hold the residue of my Estate upon trust to retain, postpone or sell it and will:

- 7.1. Pay any debts funeral and testamentary expenses.
- 7.2. Satisfy all gifts to specified property referred to in my Will.
- 7.3. Pall all gifts of money referred to in my Will.
- 7.4. Deal with the remainder ("my Residuary Estate") as I now direct.

8. **Gift of Residue**

- 8.1. I leave my residuary estate to the following:

I leave 50.00% of my residuary estate to David Cummins.

I leave 50.00% of my residuary estate to Jenny Jones.

9. **Charities**

If at my death any charity to which I have made a gift does not exist the gift will not fail but my Trustees may pay it to such other charity with similar aims as they shall think fit.

10. **Standard Provisions**

The Standard Provisions and all of the Special Provisions of the Society of Trust and Estate Practitioners (2nd Edition) shall apply.

Signing Your Will

There are certain formal procedures which you have to follow to make your Wills valid and legally binding.

You will need to sign your Will on the back page on the dotted line where it says "signature of the testator." You will need to do this in the presence of two witnesses. It is also a good idea to date the Will where indicated to do so at the front of the document and on the back page of the document where indicated to do so.

A witness must be:

- Over 18
- Someone who is not a beneficiary of your Will
- Unrelated to you or anyone mentioned in your Will although your witnesses can be related to each other

Before signing your Wills please read through them carefully to ensure that they are correct. Your witnesses should be aware they are witnessing your Will but do not need to read the contents.

Procedure

In the presence of your 2 witnesses and in the spaces provided in the Will produced:

1. Date the document where indicated , for example 31st day of August 2016
2. Sign your name as you usually do on the last page where it says " signature of the testator" whilst your two witnesses watch
3. Your 2 witnesses will then need to sign the Wills where indicated and print their names, addresses and occupations clearly where indicated to do so.
